- \* **All members who sell between 10 and 19 tickets will have their names put into a drawing. Prize value of \$25.00**

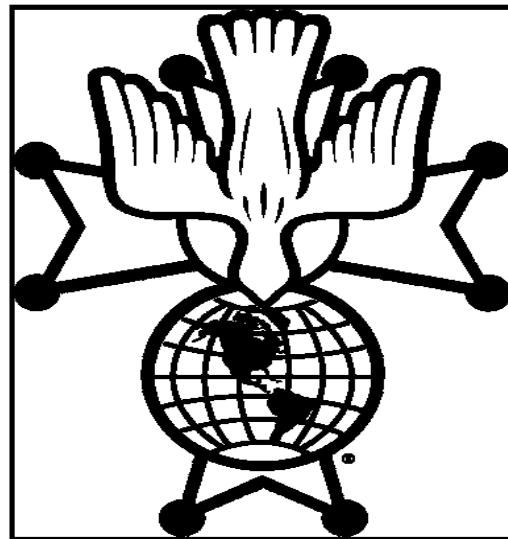
