GRAND KNIGHT'S COLUMN

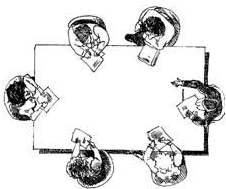

asking members of Parliament to vote down a bill that would legalize same-sex marriage in Canada. The nearly 230,000 Knights of Columbus in Canada have joined with the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops and priests across the country in the post-card campaign. Two million postcards asking Parliament to "implement legislation that will recognize, protect and reaffirm the definition of marriage as a voluntary union of one man and one woman to the exclusion of all others" were printed and distributed by Canadian Knights to parishes throughout Canada. At the Knights of Columbus Supreme Convention last August, a resolution was adopted that expressed firm opposition to same-sex marriage in Canada and the United States.
