I would like to say "Thank You" to all the people who donated blood this past year for the Knights of Columbus One-A-Week club. At a recent dinner recognizing club achievements, we were awarded an honorable mention certificate for our efforts during 2010. The total number of clubs for 2010 was 78 with a combined total of 7985 donations. Ten years earlier there were 87 clubs with

2011 Tootsie Roll Report

The 2011 Tootsie Roll Drive chaired by Bob Reich and myself was held at Festival Foods East on April 23rd-24th and before and after all masses at St. Bernard's on April 30th-May 1st. We had over 20 volunteers to support the Festival weekend, and 10+ for the church communion weekend. While there wasn't a 1:00 mass as expected, there was a large Baptism crowd after the 10:30 mass. As a group, we were able to raise a total of \$3,782 this year, which is by far our best result to date. We raised \$1,300 more than last year's revenue. This was a significant increase as Festival continues to be a very favorable location, and it was Easter weekend. Shoppers were very generous this year and the response from our parish continues to be very good.

Here is the breakdown of what was collected, and a comparison to the last few years:

As in past years, the monies collected will be split between Aspiro and the Green Bay Diocese for Ministry Persons with Disability. As with last year, we ordered 14 cases, but gave two cases to council 4505 to support their needs. As a result, we have less than a case left. Three full packs are available for purchase or as a donation to the youth group, with the remainder being shared at our next council meeting.

I would like to extend a special thank you to Bob Reich for his commitment and to all who volunteered or worked multiple shifts. Your efforts helped make this a tremendous success for our council and for the Intellectually Disabled in our community.

Minutes of last month's meeting were approved as published.

Financial Secretary Report: 142 members, 98 associate, 34 insurance, 10 inactive.

Treasurer's Report: Bob Reich: \$3064.87 in regular account, \$5363.72 in charity account.

District Deputy Report: Dave Catalano reported that the State Convention at The Radisson went very well. He heard many compliments from attendees about the raffles, ladies lunch, and the convention in general.
